The TIPEC Bristol, South West and South Wales region has for several years supported the **Great Western Air Ambulance** (GWAAC) as our chosen charity, raising more than £8,500 in donations to help fund the crucial services they provide.

These services include not only a rapid-response helicopter, but also 3 critical care vehicles that carry the same equipment and are used in many emergency situations where the nature of the reported incident doesn't require an aerial response or it is quicker to go by road.

In 2023, more than two-thirds of callouts were responded to by car but, whether by helicopter or by road vehicle, the team is on its way within four minutes of the dispatch call being received.
